

## **HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**

### **THE HERTFORDSHIRE (TEMPORARY CLOSING OF ACORN STREET, HUNSDON) ORDER 2020**

NOTICE is given that Hertfordshire County Council intends to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to prohibit all vehicular traffic from using that length of Acorn Street, Hunsdon from its junction with Church Lane north eastwards, northwards and north eastwards for a distance of approximately 333 metres (“the Road”).

An alternative route will be via Church Lane, A414 Eastwick Road, A1170 (Pepper Hill/ Amwell Hill/London Road/Viaduct Road/Bridge Foot), B1004 (Star Street/Widbury Hill/ Ware Road), B180 (Hunsdon Road/Widford Road/High Street) and Acorn Street.

The Order is needed because the installation of a new foul sewer connection is proposed to be executed on or near the Road.

If the Order is made, it shall come into force on 20 January 2020 for a period of up to 18 months. However, the restrictions specified shall only take effect at the times indicated by signs on or near the Road.

A copy of the proposed Order may be inspected free of charge at County Hall, Hertford between the hours of 9.00am and 5.00pm (excluding weekends, bank and public holidays).
