MODIFICATION ORDER 2024**

The above Order made on 11th April 2024, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by:-

Adding to them a restricted byway commencing from Hunsdon Restricted Byway 3 at TL 4151 1370 (point C on the Order Plan) and then running east south east for approximately 40 metres to a junction with Stanstead Road (public highway) at TL 4155 1368 (point D on the Order Plan)

Downgrading to a restricted byway the public right of way commencing from Hunsdon Restricted Byway 12 at TL 4100 1414 (point A on the Order Plan) and then running generally south south west past Fillets Farm for approximately 170 metres to TL 4097 1398 (point B on the Order Plan)

Adding to the particulars relating to the restricted byway Hunsdon 3 from TL 4100 1414 to TL 4155 1368 by providing that the width varies between 4 metres and 18 metres

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Hertfordshire County Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State may itself confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
