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Who can be a Councillor?

Initially, you may have little knowledge of Council work but this will come along with training, support and experience.

As a new Councillor you will bring to the Council fresh enthusiasm and new ideas, a care for your community and a willingness to learn.

A candidate for a Parish or Town Council is qualified if, when nominated –

1. he or she is a British subject or Irish citizen,
2. is 18 years of age, and
3. is either in the list of electors for that Parish or Town or has during the whole of the preceding twelve months:
 - a. occupied land as owner or tenant in it, or
 - b. had a principal place of work there, or
 - c. resided in or within three miles of it.

Disqualifications – you cannot be a councillor if you:

1. are the subject of a bankruptcy restriction order or interim order, or
2. have, within 5 years before the day of the election, been convicted in the UK of any offence and have had a prison sentence (whether suspended or not) for a period of over 3 months without the option of a fine; or
3. work for the council
