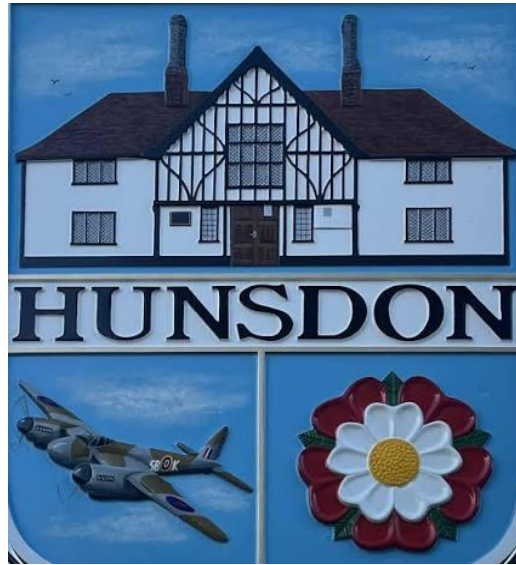


GET INVOLVED IN YOUR COMMUNITY – BECOME A PARISH COUNCILLOR

What's involved?

- Parish Councillors volunteer their time
- We meet 8 months of the year

- Bring your skills and expertise to the council and make a positive difference

What is the role of the Parish Council?

- We're here for local residents of Hunsdon and support the provision of services and facilities with money from council tax or grants - like the Sports Courts, Playground, Playing Field, Allotments and the Dell
- We are statutory consultees on all planning applications in the parish and represent the community's interests to the district and county councils on things like highways and footpaths

- Councillors are not paid and have to abide by a local government code of conduct
- Training is available with support from colleagues and the Parish Clerk
- The successful applicant will be the one who receives the majority of votes at a meeting of the Parish Council.
